Please confirm that payment will be made per the breakout sheet per the special provisions.	763000 is for initial expense, which corresponds to Note 2 on the Plans and Specifications p. 3 of 16. The remaining part of the question is regarding MOT – 763643. MOT is paid as a lump sum using the breakout sheet from the contract for each type of location.
1	Item 737523 – Plantings is a LS item with no plans or plant list. What is to be included in this price?	See note 38 on the Plans and Specifications p. 9 of 16.
