Q #	Question	Answer
1	Can you identify the owner of the marsh land on the east side of the bridge and whether access to this area is possible or does all work need to be completed from the west side or the river itself ?	The marsh itself is privately owned by Robert Patterson & Willard F. Patterson. The roadway/bike path shown on the east side of the river is owned by DelDOT. DelDOT has 15' of Right-of-Way on each side of the centerline of the path. To use this roadway as an access point for the demolition, the contractor would need to coordinate with the Dover Air Force Base. A point of contact for the Dover Air Force Base has been provided on the Notes Sheet. The Dover Air Force Base contact is Jason Halpin, and he can be reached at the number or email provided on the Notes Sheet. The contractor is allowed to work from the east side of the bridge within the LOC shown on the plans. However, if the contractor wishes to enter the construction site through the path on the east side of the river, he/she will need to coordinate with and gain approval from the Dover Air Force Base.
