4	Section 743.12 Basis of payment. Subsection B again refers to correction of edge drop offs- I don't understand where it would be an applicable instance where a traffic control contract would need to complete the work of an asphalt paver or concrete contractor in order to receive payment for the traffic control work done?	For the purposes of this contract, it is not expected that the contractor would have to address pavement edge drop-offs. Bid the items listed in the RFP only.
3	Section 743-10 Subsection G- refers to portable concrete barrier and Subsection I refers to Temporary Impact attenuators. If these work zones are all temporary on this Bid, are these items valid, or should they be deleted for the purposes of this contract? Will there be any use for them?	There is no bid item for these devices so therefore they are not included in this contract. See response number one below.
2	Section 743.10 subsection D - are tire ring bases acceptable ballast devices for plastic drums?	Yes, tire rings are acceptable ballast for plastic drums
1	Section 743.05 and 743.06 apply to pavement edge drop offs and temporary pavement markings. These items are not included in the scope of traffic control, are these valid, or should they be deleted from the bid?	The Section 743 specification included in the bid documents is DelDOT's standard specification for temporary traffic control. This specification covers all potential requirements that could be needed on any project other than special requirements. The bidder should bid on the pay items listed in the bid documents.
