5	When is the anticipated opening of the highway?	The US 301 Mainline Roadway and Interchanges are expected to be opened to public traffic in December 2018. Some new side roads constructed under the US 301 project are already open to public traffic, such as Levels Road, Jamison Corner Road and Bunker Hill Road.
4	Is landscape contractor required to flag out station locations on highway or can we perform layout of plant material by measuring off of existing structures and objects on plans provided?	No, the Contractor is not required to flag out the station locations on the highway, however per Note 7 of the Project Notes on Sheet 4, the locations of all above ground items to be installed shall be staked by the contractor and shall be verified by the engineer prior to installation. All costs incidental to Item 763501- Construction Engineering.
3	There is not a hardwood mulch item in the contract. Is mulch incidental to the planting?	"Yes, furnishing and installing mulch is incidental to Item 911000-Plantings. Per the DelDOT Standard Specifications, Mulch shall be furnished per Section 911.02.7 and Per Section 911.05, price and payment will constitute full compensation for furnishing and placing all Materials, including plants, soil mixes, and mulch. Please also note that per the Landscape Planting Notes on Plan Sheet 60, Note #11, Soil Amendments shall conform to section 911.02.5 of the Standard Specification. The contractor shall use leaf mulch in lieu of peat moss or peat humus. "
2	Breakout Sheet 4 identifies the limits as Station 347+00 to 379+50 Right. Breakout Sheet 6 identifies the limits as Station 415+00 to 435+00 Right. These station limits do not match the station limits on the contract plans. Do these breakout sheets include all work within the station limits on the plans?	Yes, Breakout Sheet 4 includes all work between Station 347+00 to 376+50 Right as identified as the limits on the Contract Plans and Breakout Sheet 6 includes all work between Station 415+00 to 437+00 as identified as the limits on the Contract Plans.
