7	<p>Page 82 of 102 of the specs, “Method of measurement” states in part, “not to exceed 2.75 gallons per square yard of surface area...”Page 83 of 102 of the spec, “Basis of Payment” states in part, “not to exceed 2.75 square yards of surface area per gallon of resin binder.”</p> <p>These two statements are in conflict. Which statement is correct, and can it please be corrected prior to bid letting?</p>	The Basis of Payment is correct. Method of Measurement should read in part, "...not to exceed 2.75 square yards of surface area per gallon of resin binder."
6	Are the Pavement Markings intended to be applied only during and after paving operations?	Pavement markings are intended to be applied to those locations that require paving. There may be a limited need for pavement markings for HFST locations, but that will be determined by the Department on a case-by-case basis.
5	Would you consider delaying the bid to consider the information in the questions above?	No.
4	Do you know locations for the paving work?	Yes, currently 11 locations require paving. Locations can be added or subtracted depending on funding or need.
3	Do you have any information on site sizes? Average Site size?	The average site size is 410 SY.
2	How many sites do you figure in total? And per zone?	There are currently 26 sites. Locations can be added or subtracted depending on funding or need.

In the BidX file, there are 80 Bid Items.</p> <p>It appears the Bid Item 0580 “Road Location Mobilization, Zone 14” is missing from the paper bidding documents, but it is shown in the BidX bid.</p> <p>Can this be corrected?</p>	<p>Road Mobilization Zone 14 has been added to plan sheet 24 for T201901006.02 per Addendum No 1.</p>
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
