Sealed bids will be received by the City of Rehoboth Beach for the Lake Avenue Streetscape Improvements, Transportation Enhancement Project, Phase I, City Project No, 2016-02, State Project No. T201220014, Federal Aid Project No. ETEA-2012(15)

The specific contract goals for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) for this contract are 12%.

Interested Contractors may purchase a copy of the Contract Documents for \$50.00 during normal working hours starting July 19, 2016, at the Office of the City Manager, City Hall Modular Unit, 229 Rehoboth Avenue, Rehoboth Beach, Delaware 19971 or electronic copies are available on the Del DOT web page <http://www.bids.delaware.gov/> at no charge starting July 14, 2016.

The work involves the furnishing of all labor, materials, transportation, tools, supplies and equipment necessary to perform the necessary construction activities for removing and replacing roadway, sidewalk, curb, drainage facilities of the Lake Avenue from Rehoboth Avenue to Third Street in the Incorporated City of Rehoboth Beach.

Sealed proposals shall be made on the Bid Proposal Forms and addressed to the City Manager at City Hall Modular Unit, 229 Rehoboth Avenue, Rehoboth Beach, Delaware 19971. The outside of the sealed envelope shall be marked as follows: Proposal for Rehoboth Beach, Lake Avenue Streetscape Improvements, Transportation Enhancement Project, Phase I. Sealed bids will be received by the City Manager until 2:00 p.m., on Thursday, August 11, 2016 in the City Manager's Office City Hall Modular Unit, 229 Rehoboth Avenue, Rehoboth Beach, Delaware 19971. Bids will be opened on same day at same location at approximately 2:01 p.m. Requirements for a 10% Bid Bond are included for this project.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Commissioner's Room located on the second floor of the Rehoboth Beach Fire Station, 219 Rehoboth Avenue, Rehoboth Beach Delaware at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday July 26, 2016. This is not a mandatory pre-bid meeting.
