Q #	Question	Answer
14	Section E3/S101 on plan page 3 of 7 indicates that insect mesh is to be places on the underside of the trusses. Please provide a specification for this mesh.	"Insect mesh" shall be synonymous with "bird netting" for this project. This screen shall be 34" square mesh such as "Bird Net 2000 by BirdBGone", "K-Net HT Bird Netting by Nixalite of America Inc." or approved equivalent.
13	Section 061000, rough carpentry, indicates that lumber is to be pressure treated. Is it the Departments intent to pressure treat all dimensional lumber lumber used for rough carpentry?	It is the intent of the Department that all dimensional lumber used for rough carpentry shall be pressure treated grade lumber.
12	Are the winches, pulleys and cable part of this contract? If so, please provide specifications for all components. How many winches per bay? They are not shown on the front elevation.	Detail E1 on sheet 3 show 2 winches, 2 pulleys, 2 steel cables and 2 hooks at the rear of each bay. Detail E2 shows 2 steel chains and 2 steel hooks at the front of each bay. Detail P2 states, "ALL HANGING COMPONENTS TO HAVE MINIMUM ALLOWABLE CAPACITY OF 3000 LBS. THIS INCLUDES: WINCHES, CHAIN, CABLES, PULLEYS AND ASSOCIATED ACCESSORIES".
11	It appears that the hopper rack at Bear is to be located in existing HMA pavement. This pavement will need to be patched after foundation construction. Is patching incidental or will the hot mix asphalt and GABC be measured and paid under their respective bid items?	Patching is incidental per the description of Location number 2 (Bear), "The scope shall also include sawcutting and any pavement repair necessary to install the racks".



	Locations 4 and 5 of Breakout Sheet 1 refer to "Base Hopper Rack Bay" and "C shaped Add on to Base Bay". Please provide definitions for each on these items and what is to be included in each of them.	locations. This includes the footings and steel but no site work (outside the actual construction of the posts) or roof systems (except holes drilled for future roof systems, like Magnolia).
4		Location 5 is for each subsequent bay connected to a location 4 bay at the particular add-on location. Because the "base" unit would already be included (as "location 4"), only three sides would essentially be needed (which is why the term "C" shaped was used in the specifications). Again this includes the footings and steel but no site work (outside the actual construction of the posts) or roof systems (except holes drilled for future roof systems, like Magnolia). Please note, we must have a location 4 bay first before we can add additional location 5 bays. There is however no limit to how may location 5 bays that can added to any given location 4 bay. This was also described on page 9 of the pre-bid transcript.

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763569 - BUILDINGS

Description:

This bid item shall consist of furnishing and installing materials and constructing the hopper racks as indicated on the Contract Drawings. The work shall include the concrete footers and piers (including anchor bolts), steel columns, steel beams, wood trusses, roofing, gutters, downspouts, bird netting, hoists, chains and all else necessary to provide the hopper racks complete per the contract drawings. Work included as part of the buildings specification breakout pay items shall be as described below.

All bid breakout items shall include the concrete footers and piers (including anchor bolts), steel columns, steel beams, hoists, and all miscellaneous items necessary to install the hopper racks complete without a roof for the amount of bays indicated on the site drawings for each site.

Location number 1 (St Georges) shall include all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to furnish and provide the 8 bay hopper rack. These hopper racks shall be furnished with the roof system (trusses, sheathing, asphalt shingles, gutters, and downspouts). The scope shall also include the relocation of the existing chain link fence, and installation of the additional chain link fence as well as all earthwork, select fill, seeding and mulching, and grading necessary to bring the subgrade to the proper grade under stone/pavement areas, or to final grade when not under impervious surface.

Location number 2 (Bear) shall include all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to furnish and provide the 12 bay hopper rack. These hopper racks shall be furnished with the roof system (trusses, sheathing, asphalt shingles, gutters, and downspouts). The scope shall also include sawcutting and any pavement repair necessary to install the racks.

Location number 3 (Magnolia) shall include all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to furnish and provide the 24 bay hopper rack with no roof system. Bid shall also include the additional earthwork, and select fill necessary to bring the subgrade to design elevation.

Location number 4 shall include all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to furnish and provide the 1 base bay hopper rack without roof system to be an optional add-on at any location. Earthwork to be evaluated at each location.

Location number 5 shall include all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to furnish and provide 1 additional "C" shaped hopper rack onto the base bay in location 4, without roof system. Earthwork to be evaluated at each location.

Materials and Construction Methods:

All materials and construction shall conform to the requirements of the Contract Drawings, DelDOT Standard Specifications and the technical specifications included as part of Appendix A.

Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting:

All bidders must be represented at the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting(s) for this contract. The meeting information is provided on the first page of this contract (page i). The bidder's representative must sign-in and identify the name of the bidder they represent.

Failure to sign-in with the bidder's company name at the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will result in the bidder being found non-responsible and non-responsive, and their bid will be rejected.

Method of Measurement:

Payment for this item will be made on a lump sum basis per location wherein no measurement will be made.

Basis of Payment:

Payment will be made at the Lump Sum price bid for this item. The price bid shall include the cost for performing the work specified and furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals necessary to provide a complete, working and usable facility acceptable to the Engineer.

Note:

The breakout sheet attached to the proposal shows the proposed Bays for this Contract. The Contractor shall fill in a price per each location. The lump sum price bid for item 763569 - Buildings shall be the sum of the total cost for all bays listed. The completed breakout sheet shall be attached to the bid proposal. Failure to submit the breakout sheet with the Bid Proposal will result in the Bid Proposal being declared non-responsive and rejected.

The Department reserves the right to delete from the Contract. The lump sum to be paid will be adjusted in accordance with the Contractor's unit prices as required above. There will be no extra compensation to the Contractor if such additions and/or deletion are made.
