The Delaware Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Office of Management and Budget-Division of Facilities Management, is soliciting Statements of Qualifications with Letters of Interest from Submitters interested in providing design-build contract services for a new Delaware Division of Motor Vehicles facility to be located at the Department's Mid-County transit hub located on US 13 south of Route 72 in New Castle County. The Project involves designing and constructing a new facility with inspection lanes to replace the existing facility along Airport Road in New Castle.

An Informational Meeting will be held in the Farmington/Felton Room of the DelDOT Administration Building, 800 Bay Road, Dover, Delaware, 19901 at 11:00 AM local time on Wednesday July 18, 2012 to discuss the project and the RFQ/RFP procurement procedure. Interested Submitters, contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers are encouraged to attend.

The Design-Build procurement process consists of the following two phases:

1. Request for Qualifications that determines the Short-List of up to three teams; and
2. Request for Proposals (RFP) from the Short-Listed firms.

Final selection and award of the contract is expected to occur late 2012. A draft version of the second phase Request for Proposals will be available in August 2012 for the Short-Listed firms from this RFQ process.

Please note the Department is not providing printed documents for this solicitation. Interested parties must use the Web document referred to above for preparing their responses. Also note, all Submissions must be in hard copy only, as described in the RFQ.

The Department of Transportation hereby notifies all submitters that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, creed, color, sex, or national origin in consideration for an award.

When it is in the best interest of the State, DelDOT may extend the time and place for the submittal of SOQs from that described above, on notice posted to the above referenced project Website.

Phase one does not require bonding. For phase two, Short-Listed firms submitting a Proposal shall provide Proposal bonds or other forms of security acceptable to the Department for a sum equal to at least 10% of the bid, or an amount stipulated in the RFP. The selected Design-Builder will be required to provide performance and payment bonds and/or other security acceptable to the Department, each in the amount of 100% of the Contract amount.
